

THAI TAPIOCA 50% RESIDUE PELLETS

Feeding Thai tapioca pellets is an ideal option with good quality pasture, helping to improve cow condition and reproduction, therefore leading to increased productivity.

Tapioca pellets are a high-starch, high energy, low fat, low NDF (Neutral Detergent Fibre) supplementary feed processed from raw tapioca roots. Tapioca is suitable for year-round feeding to dairy cows when fed as an energy supplement. But more typically, it is an ideal feed in early spring, when pasture protein levels are high.

Feeding recommendation:

Tapioca pellets are not suitable for ad lib feeding, as they put the cow at risk of ruminal acidosis. Introduce tapioca pellets gradually, in a controlled or monitored feeding regime, to allow the rumen to adapt accordingly.

Consult your farm adviser or dairy nutritionist for the optimal feeding levels for your particular situation.

Storage:

Store in a dry area to maintain quality. Moisture contact can cause growth of moulds and toxins. Precautions should be taken against rodents and birds.
